Automated Handling of Pending Tasks

A new L2-XOF3 enhancement enables the system to automatically grab tasks in "pending" state, assign them to a suitable machine, and start execution without manual input. This marks a significant step toward fully automated shop floor operations.

By eliminating manual task handling, this feature reduces delays, minimizes human error, and ensures continuous workflow execution.

Support for QR-Vet Pattern

MedTracker now supports the QR-Vet pattern, allowing users to safely generate Unique Scopes and Pools based on predefined and validated formats. This enhancement ensures standardized code structures and minimizes the risk of manual errors.



Enhanced Cryptographic Security with OpenSSL 3

MedTracker now integrates OpenSSL version 3, enabling enhanced cryptographic security and modern protocol support. This update introduces the TLSv1.3 handshake protocol, a new public key infrastructure (PKI) with a renewed root certificate using RSA 1024 and SHA-256 signature hash, along with updated dependent certificates.

As a result, the OpenSSL security level is raised, ensuring improved data protection and compliance with current security standards in regulated pharmaceutical environments.
